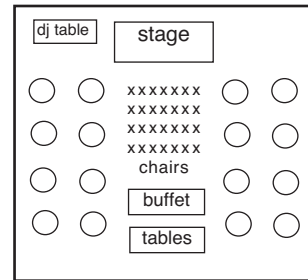
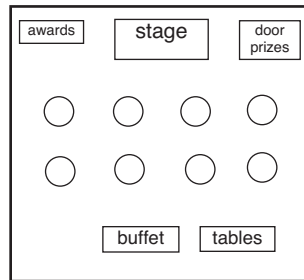
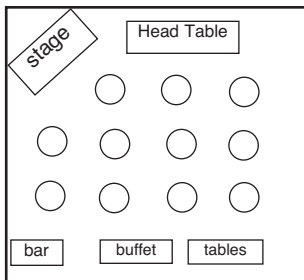


ONE-MAN COMEDY/VARIETY SHOW

PRODUCTION NOTES (for banquet halls)

- David Kaplan's **self-contained** comic / variety show is tailored to each audience and venue
- **Sound, lighting, and backdrop** can be provided by artist (when coming by car)
- A 16' wide by 8' deep stage, and a ceiling of at least 10' in height are requested (for maximum visibility, it is best to have the platform at least 2' high - taller for larger crowds)
- Because of the visual nature of the show, it is best seen from the front (like a movie)
--- **side or rear seating is not recommended**

Here are some good room layouts:



If you must have a dance floor in front of the stage, please put chairs on it for the show, then if necessary, remove the chairs for dancing

- Audience seating should start 6' from front of stage (this allows intimacy, but still leaves room for stage access)
- Please leave a few feet behind the stage for backstage preparations (if possible)
- A brief **introduction** for the show will be provided by the artist before showtime
- Set up time -- (approx. 1.5 hours)
